HEPATITIS AWARENESS & VACCINATION PROGRAM

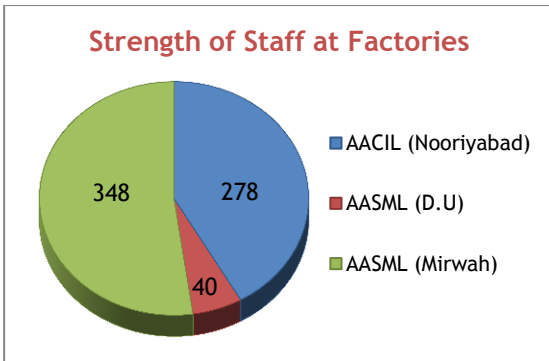
